PLASTIC PACKAGING

Condominium: Use the Yellow bin Single household: Put the waste in the yellow bags

PLASTIC

- Disposable plastic plates and glasses
- Bottles for water, soft drinks, oil, juices, milk, etc.
- Bottles for detergent, soap, miscellaneous products
- Tubes for cream, sauces, syrups, etc.
- Plastic or polystyrene packages, transparent boxes, food packages
- Food trays (eggs, ice cream, etc.)
- Containers for yoghurt, cream cheese, desserts
- Netting for fruit and vegetables
- Containers for various product packaging (cosmetics, wet wipes, powdered products)
- Pots for plants (maximum diameter 15/20 cm)
- Envelopes and bags for food in general
- Plastic for packing (wrapping for bottles, toilet paper, etc.)
- Polystyrene (if large, reduce the size)
- Empty blister packs for medication

NO Nappies



Dispose of them in the Dry Residue Waste or dedicated service (described below)

NO Toys



Dispose of non-electronic tovs in the bin for Drv Residue Waste

Use the Grey bin

CANS

Cans means all packaging in aluminium or steel

- Tins and cans for food (tuna, meat, vegetables, animal food, etc.)
- Aluminium cans for soft drinks
- Empty paint cans
- Tops and screw-on caps
- Aluminium trays for food
- Aluminium tubes (mayonnaise, creams, etc.)
- Aluminium foil (tin foil)
- Spray/aerosol cans (only if there are no danger symbols displayed on the packaging: Flame, skull and X. The spray nozzle and cap should be removed and placed in the plastic recycling bag)

Take this waste to the local recycling centre so that it can be disposed of with hazardous materials.

PAPER AND CARD-BOARD

Condominium: Use the Green bin Single household: Place the waste in a paper/cardboard box/ bag or you can use any container (e.g. bucket/old tub). Just write "paper" on it to avoid any misunderstanding.

- Newspapers and magazines
- Pizza boxes
 - Tetra Paks (iced tea, milk, fruit juice cartons)
 - Paper tablecloths Scratchcards
 - Paper towels
 - (without food residues)



• Brochures and flyers

Old exercise books

Paper bags

Break the boxes!

Crush and fold cardboard boxes to reduce their volume.



What about pizza boxes?

They should almost always be disposed of with the paper. If the base of the box is very greasy or too dirty, then they should be broken up into small pieces and disposed of with the organic waste.

Plastic bags are not paper!

If you collect paper in plastic bags, empty the contents into the White bin and dispose of the bag in the bin for plastic waste.

Some of the most common mistakes to avoid:

NO Receipts

NO Adhesive tape / packing material



Dispose of them in the Drv Residue Waste

NO Paper towels (with food residues)

Dispose of them in the Organic Waste

NO Wax paper





GLASS

• Bottles, flasks, and glass jars (remove steel and aluminium caps/lids)



What if the item is very large? Take large items, such as demijohns, to the Recycling Centre.

Remove any trace of food or liquids! Glass bottles and jars should not be washed, but as a general rule, they should be emptied thoroughly. Labels do not have to be removed.

DRY RESIDUE WASTE



Use the Green bin



Use the green semi-transparent bagswhich we delivered to you.

Dispose of the waste after correctly placing it inside the bags delivered to you.

Dry Residue Waste <u>does not mean that</u> <u>you can mix the waste</u> and avoid sorting it!

You can only dispose of the **waste that cannot be sorted in this bin**.

As for example:

- Nappies, pads and bed-wetting pads
- Sanitary towels
- Plastic cutlery
- Rubber and plastic toys
- Coffee capsules made of hard plastic
- CDs, DVDs, music cassettes and video cassettes
- Objects in ceramics, porcelain, Pyrex

glass and glass-ceramic

- Dust from vacuum cleaners or house rubbish
- X-rays, photographic films and slides
- Incandescent lamps
- Pens, felt pens and stationery in general
- Toothbrushes and sponges
- Wax, laminated and thermal paper (receipts, etc.)
- Baking paper, dirty paper and wet wipes
- Tights and stockings

- Cigarette butts
- (extinguished)
- Disposable masks and gloves
- Mirrors and crystal
- Cups made of glass
- Straws
- Pet litter

Some of the most common mistakes to avoid:

NO Organic waste



NO Paper and cardboard



NO Plastic



NO Wood ash



Dispose of it in the bin for Organic Waste (inside a bag and extinguished)

ORGANIC WASTE



- Fruit and vegetables waste
- Meat and fish in small pieces
- Dairy products
- Egg shells
- Grounds of tea and coffee or of other

infusion drinks

- Paper napkins or tissues
- Sawdust and wood ash (with no embers and packaged)
- Absorbent kitchen roll (damp or oily)
- Leaves and soil
- Mussel and clam shells or other shellfish
- Kitchen paper towels (wet or greasy)



Close the bag well! Dispose of the waste only after placing it in biodegradable and/or compostable bags.

NO Cat litter



Pet litter should generally be made of silicone (or similar) and disposed of with the Dry Residue Waste unless otherwise specified on the packaging (some litters are biodegradable and/or compostable)

NO Nappies



Dispose of them in the bin for the Dry Residue Waste or Dedicated service

NO Plastic bags



Dispose of Organic Waste in biodegradable bags, not in plastic bags

Collection Bulky waste

Mobile Collection Points

Do you have bulky waste to discard?

Just take your handset! Free call... Free collection.

Disposing of your bulky waste is **easy and free**, thanks to the collection service on request.

How to request it: To book the service, call the Toll Free Number 800 012 572

How and when it is collected: The Customer Service Office indicates the date of collection and the previous evening the user must place the bulky waste outside his house.

What you can dispose of: Bulky waste such as: cupboards, sofas, mattresses, armchairs, chairs, desks... or WEEE (Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment) such as refrigerators, monitors, televisions, washing machines, water heaters...

You can also use the Mobile Collection Points

In the collection points available in urban areas and the countryside, it is possible to deliver the same waste accepted at the Municipal Recycling Centre with the exception of **inert waste**, which will not be accepted. Remember that a maximum of three items at a time can be collected. In specific cases or if you need to dismantle a piece of furniture or a bulky item, we recommend calling the toll free number **800 012 572** for correct information on how to make transportation easier.

MOBILE COLLECTION POINTS: WHERE AND WHEN YOU CAN USE THEM

- Collection point in **Piazzale Segni** in Sassari Present **every Tuesday from 8 am to 1 pm**
- Collection point in **Via Camboni** (Li Punti)
- Present every Thursday from 8 am to 1 pm
- There are also collection points **in the countryside**. The calendar for this area varies and so should be checked on the website **differenziatasassari.it**
